Firmware Updating Instructions for SeaLife Micro HD / HD+ Underwater Camera

Firmware version V1.55 (HD+) and V2.55 (HD) released on August 5, 2015. Fixes power ON and lock-up issues when battery is empty.

- 1. Before starting firmware update, make sure camera's battery has at least 50% charge.
- 2. Download firmware for your camera model from the following link and save it to your PC desktop: Micro HD SL500 version V2.55: <u>https://www.dropbox.com/s/2i2dtksfluhzj5j/sealifefw.bin?dl=0</u> Micro HD+ SL501 version V1.55: <u>https://www.dropbox.com/s/fkvlv2kw5gw5jm8/sealifefw.bin?dl=0</u>
- Connect camera to your PC using the USB cable. For Windows PC, the camera memory drive "Removable disk (__:)" under "My Computer" menu. For Mac, the camera memory drive "NO NAME __" on the desktop.
- 4. Copy the "sealifefw.bin" file from your desktop and paste it to the "Removable disk (_:)" for PC, or "NO NAME __" for Mac. Note: Make sure the "sealifefw.bin" file name has not been altered (must be "sealifefw.bin") and that it's located next to the DCIM folder, not inside the DCIM folder
- 5. Disconnect the camera from PC.
- 6. Power on camera.
- 7. "Processing" appears on the display, indicating FW update is in progress.
- 8. It takes about 45 seconds to update.
- 9. FW file automatically deletes itself after the update is complete.
- 10. To confirm that the firmware has updated correctly, power on the camera, push the Menu key, select "System Settings" using the up/down keys and push shutter button to confirm. Use up/down key and scroll down to "Firmware Version:" which should be V1.55 for Micro HD+ or V2.55 for Micro HD.
